
## O bservation in S cience

## Materials:

Whole milk	Pie pan or petri dish	Dishwashing soap
Food coloring (4 colors)	Toothpick	

## What to do:

- 1. Put the pie pan on a flat surface.
- 2. Fill the pie pan half full with the whole milk.
- 3. Drop one drop of each color of food coloring into the pie pan. Use the diagram below as a guide.




4.	What observations can you make about the food coloring and milk?

- 5. Dip one end of the toothpick into the dishwashing soap.
- 6. Touch the milk in the **middle** of the pie pan with the soapy end of the toothpick.
- 7. Now what observations can you make?
